We ask all residents to discuss safety matters such as observing speed limit, safe play activities, and Park Rules with their families and guests. Thank you for helping to keep our residents safe!

PARK NEWS:

Utility Rates: The current PG&E and Daly City Water rates are posted in the Park office and in the glass information case located by the clubhouse. These are updated as the newest information is received.

The CARE/FERA utility discount info and Medical Baseline application and info are available at the Park. After you complete the form, the Park office staff will complete the account number sections on the form and submit it to CARE/FERA on your behalf.

STREET LIGHTS: Routine street light inspection is performed regularly by Park maintenance. If you should notice a street light out please do not hesitate to call the office to report. Maintenance does their best to keep all the lights working and we appreciate your help identifying areas that need attention.

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Safety & Policy

- **Speed Limit and Safe Driving Practices:** The Park speed limit is **15 MPH**. We ask residents and their guests to observe this important safety rule.
- **Guests:** A reminder to Park residents to obtain guest parking passes at the Park office for your guests. Guest parking is located in the parking area by the clubhouse. In order to accommodate the guest parking needs of all park residents, a limit of five (5) passes only will be issued by the courtesy patrol. If you have additional need due to special considerations, please contact the office. Thanks for your understanding and cooperation.
- **Street Parking** is allowed in the Park, except during the hours of 1AM and 5AM. However, management asks that you extend the courtesy of not parking in front of your neighbor's homes at any time. Blocking the space in front of your resident's homes may prevent someone with special mobility needs from accessing their space. Please ask your guests to utilize designated guest parking areas or park in front of your home or in your driveway if room allows.
- **Alcohol & Common Area:** "Alcohol, or other prohibited activity", is not permitted anywhere in the common areas, including the BBQ area, clubhouse and pool. This is specifically stated in the Park Rules and is for the safety of all. **No Jump Houses are allowed in any of the common areas or on resident lots.**
- **Spa and Pool** - Appropriate swim wear should be worn at all times when using the Spa and Pool. This is a health code requirement and important to keep the filters and equipment operating properly. Please let's all work together to keep equipment in working order.
- **Quiet Time begins at 10PM** - Management asks all residents and their guests to respect other residents' rights to the quiet enjoyment of their homes by observing the Park's quiet time hours. The sound of late night car stereos, car alarms, or loud talking really carries and is disturbing to others. Thanks for your help!
- **Please observe fire regulations:** and safe practices regarding use of barbecues. Barbecues need to be kept a safe distance from your home and never left unattended. All other types of fire pits or open flame devices are prohibited in the Park.

- **Please do not discard any of the above items in the park, at the laundry mats, parking areas, homes for sale, streets, or hillside. If we establish identity of anyone "dumping, or discarding trash, or unwanted items" (anywhere on the property site), they will be dealt with accordingly.**

- **FREE Electronic Waste drop off** - It is illegal to throw electronic waste in the trash or to dump anything on public or private property - including sidewalks, roads, and parks. 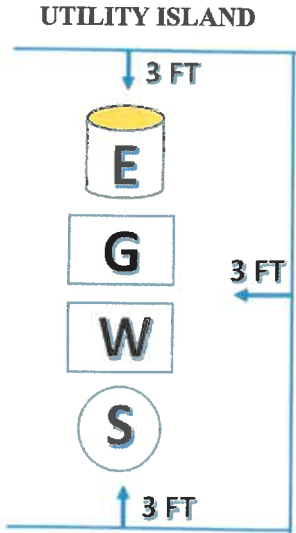
GAS AWARENESS

The Franciscan Park is supplying you with gas through an underground system of gas mains and service piping.

As gas operators, the Park is constantly striving to provide you with product in the safest, most efficient manner possible. The following are a few ways you can help us provide a safe and reliable product.

- **If you suspect a gas leak (gas smells like “sulfur” or “rotten eggs”), call the emergency numbers listed below. Leave the area immediately and call from a secure location outside the home.**
- **DO NOT:**
 - ❖ Turn on or off any electrical switch or appliance (lights, garbage disposal, etc.).
 - ❖ Start any machinery (washer, dryer, dishwasher, or other appliances, etc).
 - ❖ Operate cell phones or door bells in the effected area.
- All excavation/digging must be reported to the gas operator, The Franciscan Park, at least 48 hours prior to the start of the work. Work may not start until Park management has given the approval to start. Failure to do so may place the public in considerable danger and will subject the excavator/digger to significant liability for damage, as well as, for lost product.

*****BEFORE YOU DIG CALL:** Management Office (650)755-3483***Management must approve any digging prior to the start of any home improvement project! Once you obtain Park approval you must also contact  **811** Know what's below. Call before you dig. **PRIOR** to digging as well as a private utility locating company at the **expense of the homeowner.**

Annual Clean-Up Guidelines

Republic Services offers its customers in Daly City, Colma and Broadmoor one annual "by appointment" clean-up free of charge between January and December. Customers are required to contact Republic Services at least two weeks in advance by calling (650) 756-1130 to schedule an appointment for a personalized collection day.

- We will collect up to 12 32-gallon sized trash bags or bundles.
- All trash must be bagged, bundled, boxed or containerized (except large bulky items), and must not weigh more than 60 lbs. each.
- All wood must be bundled, no greater than 2 feet in diameter and 4 feet in length, and must not weigh more than 60 lbs.
- You may place 2 large items not exceeding 200 lbs. each.
- If you have large items such as mattresses, furniture, appliances, scrap metal, rimless tires (up to 4), etc. please indicate this when scheduling your appointment as Republic Services will send a special truck to accommodate this load.
- TVs will be considered 1 large item.
- Please have items set out by 4:00 a.m. on your prescheduled day or night before. Set items out curbside or at the end of your driveway.

Additional Information

Please notify Republic Services at least 24 hours in advance of your scheduled cleanup if additional items require collection.

Debris Box Service

- If you have more items than requirements allow, Republic Services also offers extra collection and/or debris box service. Please note additional charges for extra material collection and debris box service will apply.
- Republic Services debris box services range in size from 8-cubic yards to 30-cubic yards. For more information and to schedule delivery call (650) 756-1130 or email to infodalacity@republicservices.com



What Republic Services Will Not Pick Up

For the safety of our customers and employees, Republic Services cannot pick up the following items:

- Motor vehicles
- Motorcycles
- Vehicle parts and batteries
- Construction debris (dirt, rock, stucco, concrete)
- Hot ashes
- Animal waste
- Poison oak
- Commercial refrigerators
- Hazardous Waste (toxic substances, paint, thinners)
